- » **Main Event Volunteer** — Assist volunteer or participant registration
- » **Main Event Course Support Volunteer** — Assist with duties such as water stations, course support, security and bike valet parking and the Lock 3 Celebration

Chaperones will be asked to stay over approximately 20 additional minutes to review some specific details.
